Competitions:

Undergraduate Posters

Posters must focus on the application of GIS, GNSS (GPS), or related technologies. Posters must be based upon original work and completed as an undergraduate. Submittal of projects done for class is encouraged. *All posters* will be displayed at the 2016 IMAGIN Conference in Traverse City. **Graduate Papers**

Papers must focus on the application of GIS, GNSS (GPS), or related technologies and must be limited to a maximum of 4000 words of text. Submittal of thesis or dissertation research is encouraged. Paper competition participants must present their work to be eligible for scholarships. Authors of the *top three* papers will be invited to present their papers at the 2016 IMAGIN Conference in Traverse City.
